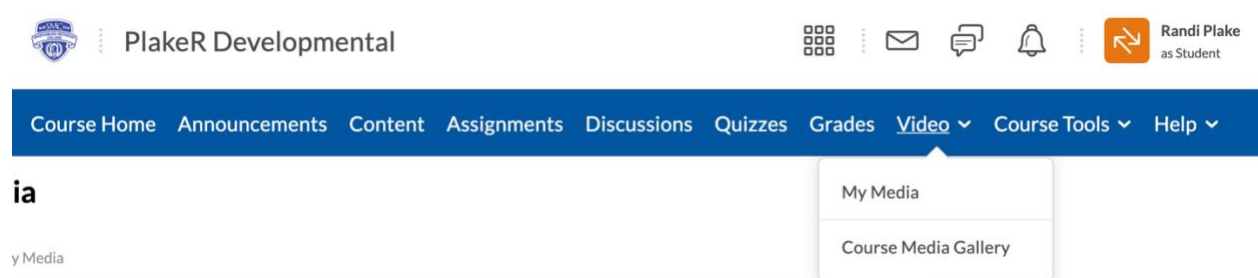
### Kaltura Capture

My Media is located on the NavBar of the Brightspace homepage. It can always be easily accessed by clicking Video at the top of any Brightspace page. My Media is a repository for all of your videos, which can then be distributed to any of your courses.

Every user has a personal, searchable repository for viewing and managing private media content. The videos you record using Kaltura Capture will be published to My Media.

The Course Media Gallery is a searchable gallery of media content of a particular course. Basically, every video you create for a particular course gets stored here.
